

PRAYER POCKET NOTES.....

"No one's relationship with Christ will rise above the level of his or her praying. Put simply, if your prayer life is inconsistent and weak....your relationship with God will be as well." Dr. Gregory R. Frizzell.

JULY: *Matthew 6:9-13* Jesus saw a need to give His disciples an example of how to pray. We are not tied to use only this prayer nor does it need to be continuously repeated at one session. Christ was making known in as few and simple words possible for us, how and what we should be praying. Notice the first portion relates to God and His honor and the last, our concerns. This prayer teaches us to seek first the kingdom of God and His righteousness, and then all the other things will be added.

AUGUST: If the prayer of one righteous person avails much, just think about what the prayers of two or more righteous people will accomplish. *"Again I say unto you, that if two of you shall agree on earth as touching anything that they shall ask, it shall be done for them of my Father which is in heaven. For where two or three are gathered together in my name, there am I in the midst of them.*

(Matt. 18:19-20, KJV). Whenever we pray in agreement with another person, God promises to answer our requests, and He promises to be in the midst of us as we pray with two or more people.
