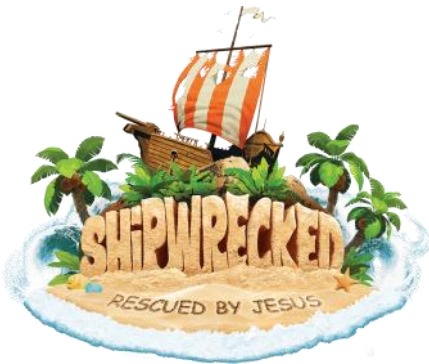

## PRAYER POCKET NOTES.....

*"No one's relationship with Christ will rise above the level of his or her praying. Put simply, if your prayer life is inconsistent and weak....your relationship with God will be as well." Dr. Gregory R. Frizzell.*

*Lamentations 3: The chapter begins with a heart wrenching lament over the destruction and captivity of God's chosen people. Plagued by sin and rebellion, the Israelites rejected the promised of God despite all of the miraculous ways He had rescued and provided for them. Eventually, the Lord allowed them to go their own way, which had devastating consequences. The land was ravaged and conquered and the people were taken captive. Jeremiah felt crushed by the weight of sin and despair.*

*However in verse 21 and following he remembered the goodness of God: "Yet this I call to mind, and therefore I have hope: Because of the Lord's faithful love we do not perish, for His mercies never end. They are new every morning; Great is your faithfulness!" He was able to lift his eyes to a faithful God full of mercy, who gives us new opportunities each day and doesn't abandon us in our sins. When the weight of sin overwhelms you, call on Jesus, who is a merciful and faithful Savior. Even if the whole world seems to be decimated, the truth of the scriptures remains unchanged.*
